

Project Grad Open Board and Chair Positions

Vice President	OPEN	Share in president responsibilities with intent to take over president position for the 2020/2021 school year. (President responsibilities: Request updates to web site; maintain insurance; reserve facilities; work information tables and/or speak at school informational nights; attend monthly MEF/Boosters/PG/Admin joint meetings; attend county PG bimonthly meetings; run monthly PG meetings; coordinate with all other PG board/chair positions)
Carnival	OPEN	Order supplies for carnival. Friday afternoon, May 31, direct crew to decorate carnival booths before 8:30 party time. Direct group of volunteers to work carnival booths during party and pack up carnival supplies after carnival closes. This person should plan on attending the PG party until 2:00 a.m.
Construction Cafeteria	OPEN	Wednesday, May 29, 3:00-6:00 p.m. (approx). Use ladders to run ceiling wires. Use scissor lift to hang gossamer for false ceiling, run twinkle lights on ceiling and hang stars. Assemble gazebo, EZ-ups, move tables/chairs.
Electrical	OPEN (Mike Lovelace will train)	Direct a crew of volunteers to run extension cords, plug in lights, etc. Requires getting on roof to plug in extension cords. Saturday, May 25, 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.; Thursday, May 30, 4:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m.; Friday, May 31, 4:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m., Saturday, June 1, 6:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. for clean-up.
Tear-Down	OPEN (2 POSITIONS)	Direct crew of volunteers to take down and store all Project Grad decorations and supplies. Saturday, June 1, 6:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. Usually get two shifts of helpers. 6-10 & 10-2. About 5-6 people per shift.
